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**Item 1.01      Entry into a Material Definitive Agreement.**

On February 14, 2005, Metro One Telecommunications, Inc. (the Company ) entered into a Master Services Agreement for Directory Assistance Services (the Services Agreement ) with Nextel Operations, Inc., acting on behalf of certain affiliates (collectively Nextel ) of Nextel Communications, Inc. The Services Agreement, which was made effective as of January 1, 2005, supercedes the previous services agreement between the parties dated June 26, 1999.

Under the Services Agreement, the Company will provide directory assistance services to Nextel s customers on a non-exclusive basis. Price levels in the Services Agreement are lower than those of the previous agreement and, additionally, Nextel may transition call volume away from the Company on short notice and/or terminate services entirely. The term of the Services Agreement is for three years, and may be renewed by Nextel for two additional one-year periods.
