ITEM 1.01. ENTRY INTO A MATERIAL DEFINITIVE AGREEMENT.

On May 29, 2008, NewStar Financial, Inc. (the Company) entered into the Seventh Amendment and Waiver (the Amendment), dated as of May 29, 2008, to the Secured Loan and Servicing Agreement (the Agreement), dated as of August 26, 2005, by and among NewStar Short-Term Funding LLC, as the borrower, the Company, as the originator and the servicer, MMP-5 Funding, LLC as the lender, NATIXIS Financial Products, Inc., as the administrative agent and U.S. Bank National Association, as the trustee. The primary purpose of the Amendment to the Agreement was to extend the maturity date of the Agreement to May 22, 2009.
