<b>Interest Rate and Interest Payment Dates During Floating Rate Period:</b>	Annual rate equal to three-month Sterling LIBOR +170.5 bp, from and including March 15, 2017, payable quarterly in arrears on each March 15, June 15, September 15 and December 15, beginning on June 15, 2017. If three-month Sterling LIBOR cannot be determined for the quarterly interest period beginning on March 15, 2017 in the manner specified in the preliminary prospectus supplement for the 5.75% Series A-2 Junior Subordinated Debentures, three-month Sterling LIBOR will be 5.53%.
