On February 6, 2019, at a special meeting of members of Lake Shore, MHC (the "MHC"), the mutual holding conformation of Lake Shore Bancorp, Inc. (the "Company"), the members of the MHC (i.e., depositors of Lake Shore Savings voted to approve the MHC's waiver of quarterly dividends declared by the Company on its common stock during twelve months subsequent to the members approval (i.e., through February 6, 2020), of up to \$0.12 per share.	Bank)
Historically, the MHC has waived its right to receive dividends declared on its shares of the Company's common stock. However, the Federal Reserve Board adopted interim final regulations that impose additional conditions of	

stock. However, the Federal Reserve Board adopted interim final regulations that impose additional conditions on the ability of mutual holding companies to waive the receipt of dividends declared by their subsidiaries, including the requirement to obtain member approval prior to a mutual holding company's decision to waive the receipt of dividends. Following the receipt of member approval, the MHC will apply to the Federal Reserve Board for its non-objection to dividend waivers by the MHC for the next 12 months. If this non-objection is obtained from the Federal Reserve Board prior to March 15, 2019, the expected payment date of the fourth quarter 2018 dividend, the MHC intends to waive its receipt of such dividend.

On February 6, 2019, the Company's Board of Directors declared a quarterly cash dividend of \$0.12 per share on its outstanding common stock. The dividend is payable on March 15, 2019 to shareholders of record as of February 21, 2019.
