On May 6, 2004, Jeffrey Revell Reade, an Australian citizen, acquired 60,000,000 shares of Multi-Tech International, Corp.'s ("Company") Common Stock ("Shares") pursuant to a Stock Purchase Agreement among Mr. Reade and the Company (the "Agreement") for a price of \$440,000. As a result of the stock sale, Mr. Reade now owns 75% of the total outstanding shares of the Company.

The current number of issued and outstanding shares of the Company is 80,000,000. Consequently, as a result of Mr. Reade's acquisition, he is now considered a control person of the Company.
